### **General Instructions**

- 1. Before submission of the online Application Form, the candidate should read this notification carefully.
- 2. On behalf of the Gujarat State, The Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda, Vadodara, the Nodal Agency announces holding of the 12<sup>th</sup> Gujarat State Eligibility Test (GSET) on 27<sup>th</sup> August 2017 (SUNDAY) for determining the Eligibility of Gujarat state's candidates for Assistant Professor in universities and colleges of Gujarat State. The Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda, Vadodara, State Agency will conduct GSET in 23 subjects at 6 Centres in Gujarat.
- 3. The candidates who qualify the Gujarat State Eligibility Test for eligibility for Assistant Professor will be governed by the rules and regulations for recruitment of Assistant Professor of the concerned Universities / Colleges / State Government of Gujarat State, as the case may be.
- 4. The result of the GSET to be held on 27<sup>th</sup> August 2017 (SUNDAY) will be made available on the GSET websites: www.gujaratset.ac.in as and when it is declared. The candidates will not be individually intimated about their result.
- 5. The Candidates of Gujarat State belonging to Scheduled Caste (SC)/Scheduled Tribe (ST)/ Physically Handicapped (PH) / Visually Handicapped (VH) /Other Backward Classes (OBC) (Non-creamy layer) as per the central list of Other Backward Classes available on National Commission for Backward Classes (NCBC), Government of India website: www.ncbc.nic.in, will be given such special concessions as may be decided by the Agency.
- 6. The candidates of other States, i.e. other than Gujarat State, belonging to reserved category shall be treated as General category candidates.

### **MODE OF PAYMENT**

- The candidate is expected to Register online and download online application form and Bank Challan Form in triplicate (Bank Copy, GSET Copy & Candidate's Copy) as given in the Notification.
- All the three copies of the Challan Form along with requisite fee have to be submitted in any branch of Bank of Baroda.
- Candidates can deposit the requisite fee in Bank of Baroda only on next working day of online registration and downloading the challan from GSET Website
- The bank will retain one copy and return two copies of the challan to the candidate.
- It is mandatory for the candidate to keep and preserve GSET copy and Candidate's Copy of the challan with him/her for future reference.
- The candidate should note that the printout of online Application Form, bank challan
  or any other certificate or document is not required to be sent to Gujarat State
  Eligibility test office, Vadodara before he / she is declared as qualified in the GSET
  Examination.
- After declaration result of GSET Examination, if candidate is declared as qualified, GSET copy of Bank Challan have to be mandatorily submitted along with the printout of online Application Form, Original Hall Ticket and other certificates at the time of document verification at Gujarat State Eligibility test office, Vadodara.
- Please note that fee submitted by any other mode like money order, demand draft, IPO etc.
   will be rejected.
- Fee once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.

## **Condition of Eligibility**

- Only those candidates are eligible to appear in the GSET who have completed / are studying in the final year or semester of a UGC specified Master's degree.
- Candidates who have secured at least 55% marks (General) (without rounding off) in Master's Degree OR equivalent examination from universities/institutions recognised by UGC in Humanities (including languages) and Social Science, Computer Science & Applications, Sciences are eligible for GSET Examination. The Other Backward Classes (OBC) belonging to non-creamy layer / Scheduled Caste (SC)/Scheduled Tribe (ST)/ Physically Handicapped (PH)/ Visually Handicapped (VH) category candidates who have secured at least 50% marks (without rounding off) in Master's degree or equivalent examination are eligible for GSET Examination.
- Candidates who have appeared OR will be appearing in the final year / semster at the qualifying Master's degree examination and whose result is still awaited OR candidates whose qualifying examinations have been delayed may also apply for GSET Examination. However, such candidates will be admitted provisionally and shall be considered eligible for eligibility of Assistant Professor only after they have passed their Master's degree examination or equivalent with at least 55% marks (50% marks in case of Other Backward Classes (OBC) belonging to non-creamy layer / SC/ST/PH/VH category candidates). Such candidates must complete their Master's degree examination within two years from the date of declaration of result of GSET Examination with required percentage of marks, failing which they will be treated as disqualified.
- The Ph.D. degree holders whose Master's level examination had been completed by 19<sup>th</sup> September, 1991 (irrespective of date of declaration of result) shall be eligible for a relaxation of 5% in aggregate marks (i.e., from 55% to 50%) for appearing in the GSET Examination.
- Candidates are required to appear for GSET in the subject of their Post Graduation only. In case the subject of a candidate is not included in the list of GSET subjects, the candidates may appear in UGC NET / UGC CSIR NET which is held twice a year.
- Those candidates who are studying in the first year of two years course or in first two semesters of a four semester's course or in first four semesters of a six semester's course of Master's Degree cannot appear for this GSET Examination.
- Candidates having post-graduate diploma/certificate awarded by Indian University/Institute or foreign degree/diploma/certificate awarded by the foreign University/Institute should in their own interest, ascertain the equivalence of their diploma/degree/certificate with Master's degree of recognized Indian universities from Association of Indian Universities (AIU), New Delhi. (www.aiuweb.org)
- Candidates are neither required to send any certificate / documents in support of their eligibility nor printout of their Application Form to Gujarat State Eligibility Test office, Vadodara. However the candidates, in their own interest, must satisfy themselves about their eligibility for GSET Examination. In the event of any ineligibility being detected by GSET / UGC at

- any stage, their candidature will be cancelled, the award / certificate will be withdrawn and they shall be liable for legal action.
- Candidates belonging to SC / ST / PH / VH / OBC (Cast Certificate along with latest Non Creamy Layer certificate) category must possess Valid Category Certificate issued by competent authority of Gujarat state and certificates related to PH / VH. Therefore, the candidates, in their own interest, must satisfy themselves about their eligibility for GSET Examination. In the event of any ineligibility being detected by GSET / UGC at any stage, their candidature will be cancelled, award / certificate will be withdrawn and they shall be liable for legal action.
- The candidates of other States, i.e. other than Gujarat State, belonging to reserved category shall be treated as General category candidates.
- Candidates should note that their candidature is provisional. The mere fact that Online Application Form and Examination Fee accepted and Hall Ticket issued to a candidate will not imply that GSET Agency has accepted his / her candidature. Their candidature will be deemed final only upon verification of eligibility conditions with reference to the claims made in their application, after the result of GSET Examination. In the event a candidate being found ineligible at any stage for the award due to any reason (including unintentional computer error or printer's devil etc.), he / she will be declared as not-qualified in GSET Examination and award / certificate will be withdrawn.
- GSET Agency will not issue any mark sheet to qualified / not-qualified candidates. The GSET Agency will issue certificate to the qualifying candidates only on verification of the Eligibility Documents immediately after the result of the GSET Examination.
- There is no upper age limit applying in GSET for eligibility of Assistant Professor.

## **Exemption from GSET**

- Exemption from GSET will be as per decisions taken by the UGC and Government of Gujarat from time to time.
- NET/SLET/SET shall remain the minimum eligibility condition for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professors in Universities/Colleges/Institutions. Provided, however, that candidates, who are or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the "University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree), Regulation 2009, shall be exempt from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions."
- The candidates who have passed the UGC/CSIR JRF examination prior to 1989 are also exempted from appearing in NET.
- For SET Candidates: The candidates who have cleared the State Eligibility Test (SET) accredited
  by UGC for eligibility for Assistant Professor held prior to 1st June 2002, are exempted from
  appearing in NET, being eligible to apply for Assistant Professor anywhere in India. For SET held
  from 1st June 2002 onwards, the qualified candidates are eligible to apply for the post of Assistant

Professor only in the universities/ colleges belonging to the state from where they have cleared their SET.

### Scheme of Examination

 GSET Examination will consist of three papers. All the three papers will consist of only objective type questions and will be held in two separate sessions as under:

- Paper-I shall be of general nature, intended to assess the teaching/research aptitude of the candidate. It will primarily be designed to test reasoning ability, comprehension, divergent thinking and general awareness of the candidate. 60 (Sixty) multiple choice questions of 2 marks each will be given, out of which the candidate would be required to answer any 50 (Fifty). In the event of the candidate attempting more than 50 questions, the first 50 questions attempted by the candidate would be evaluated.
- Paper-II shall consist of 50 (Fifty) objective type compulsory questions based on the subject selected by the candidate. Each question will carry 2 marks.
- Paper-III will consist of 75 (Seventy Five) objective type compulsory questions from the subject selected by the candidate. Each question will carry 2 marks.
- All questions of Paper-II and Paper-III will be compulsory, covering entire syllabus (including all electives, without options).
- The candidate will have to mark the responses for questions of Paper I, Paper II and Paper III on the Optical Mark Reader (OMR) Sheet provided.
- There is no provision of re evaluations of papers.

# **Syllabus of GSET Examination**

Syllabus for GSET Examination will be the same as UGC / CSIR NET. Syllabi for all Gujarat SET
(GSET) subjects can be downloaded from the GSET Website <a href="www.gujaratset.ac.in">www.gujaratset.ac.in</a>. GSET Agency,
Vadodara will not send the syllabus to individual candidates.

## Provisions for persons with disability

• For Visually Handicapped (VH) candidates, 25 (Twenty Five) minutes' compensatory time shall be provided separately for paper-I and Paper-II. For paper-III, 50 (Fifty) minutes' compensatory time shall be provided. They will also be provided the services of a scribe who would be a graduate in a subject other than that of the candidate. Those Physically Handicapped (PH) candidates who are not in a position to write in their own hand-writing can also avail these services by making prior request (at least one week before the date of GSET Examination) in writing to the GSET Agency office, Vadodara. Compensatory time and facility of scribe would not be provided to other Physically Handicapped (PH) candidates.

### **Procedure and Criteria for Declaration of Result**

### This will comprise of the following:

Top 6% of the appearing candidates who appear in all three papers and secure at least 40% of aggregate marks for candidates belonging to GENERAL Category and at least 35% of aggregate marks for candidates belonging to reserved categories, viz., SC, ST, OBC (belonging to Non Creamy Layer), and PWD will be declared qualified for Eligibility for Assistant Professor by following the reservation policy of Government of India.

It may be noted that the above qualifying criteria is final and binding.

#### **Hall Ticket**

It may be noted that the hall ticket will be uploaded on the website <a href="www.gujaratset.ac.in">www.gujaratset.ac.in</a> 7 days prior to Examination day. No hall ticket will be sent to the candidates by post. The candidates should download their hall ticket from the website to ascertain their venue of GSET Examination as mentioned in the Hall Ticket and appear in the examination only at the designated examination center. No candidate will be allowed to appear at the examination center other than that allotted to him/her in the Hall Ticket.

## **How to Apply (Application to be submitted Online)**

## **Steps for submission of Online Application Form**

- The candidates must read the 'ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA' carefully and must satisfy themselves
  regarding their eligibility for GSET Examination before filling the online application and depositing
  examination fee. Before applying Online, candidates are advised to go through detailed notification
  available at GSET website and also to be shortly published in the Local Newspapers and
  Employment News.
- Candidate seeking admission to GSET Examination must apply online through a link "REGISTER ONLINE FOR GSET EXAM" available on the GSET website: www.gujaratset.ac.in.
- Before applying Online, the candidates must possess the Scanned passport (pp) size photograph in JPEG format and should not be more than 100kb.
- Candidate has to visit the GSET website to fill up the Application Form Online. Please fill correct information carefully in the online application form and follow the on screen instructions for filling up application form. Confirm that your Name, Subject, Centre, Category, Physically or Visually disability, recent passport size photo scanned in JPEG format and not be more then 100kb and all other details filled are correct. Otherwise no correction will be made after you submit the application form. Gujarat SET Office will not be responsible for loss arising out of these to the candidates.
- After successful submission and confirmation, the candidate should take printout of filled online Application Form and Computerised Bank Challan on A-4 size paper only. It is mandatory for the candidate to keep and preserve printout of filled online Application Form with him/her for future reference.
- After Online Registration and downloading online application form and Bank Challan to pay
  examination fee, Candidates can deposit the requisite fee in any branch of Bank of Baroda, on
  next working day of online registration & generating the challan from GSET Website.
- It is compulsory to register online for GSET Examination and pay the requisite fee in the bank after downloading the bank challan and application form. No other means/ mode of application will be accepted.
- Please note that Fee submitted through any other mode like Money Order, Demand Draft, IPO etc.
   will be summarily rejected.
- Due to Technical or any other reason, if the Scanned passport (pp) size photograph uploaded by candidate does not appear / printed properly on Print out of Online Application form, Candidates are requested to send the Scanned passport (pp) size photograph immediately on E-Mail: gujaratset@gmail.com
- The candidates are required to bring a photo identity card also along with their printout of online Examination Hall Ticket on the day of examination.

- The candidates are requested to ascertain their venue of GSET Examination mentioned in the

  be allowed to the examination centre / hall after commencement of examination. No candidate will

be allowed to leave the examination hall / room before 12 : 15 P.M. in the first session and 04 : 30 P.M. in the second session.

- The use of calculators or Log Tables is not permitted. Mobile phones, pagers and electronic
  devices, bits of paper, books / note books etc. are not allowed in the Examination Hall/Room. The
  candidate(s) found in possession of any of these items in the examination hall / room will be treated
  as unfair means and his / her result will not be declared.
- The candidates have to follow the instructions given by the invigilators in the examination hall / room
  and should not argue with the invigilators or other staff involved in the examination duty at the
  examination centre. The candidates, who will not follow the instructions, will be treated as unfair
  means and his / her result will not be declared.
- In the examination hall / room, the candidates will neither talk to each other nor discuss any matter during the examination. The candidates should not disturb the candidates in the examination room and maintain complete silence during the examination. The candidate violating these instructions will be treated as unfair means and his / her result will not be declared.
- For Visually Handicapped (VH) candidates, 25 (Twenty Five) minutes' compensatory time shall be provided separately for paper-I and Paper-II. For paper-III, forty 50(Fifty) minutes' compensatory time shall be provided. They will also be provided the services of a scribe who would be a graduate in a subject other than that of the candidate. Those Physically Handicapped (PH) candidates who are not in a position to write in their own hand-writing can also avail these services by making prior request (at least one week before the date of GSET Examination) in writing to the GSET Agency office, Vadodara. Compensatory time and facility of scribe would not be provided to other Physically Handicapped (PH) candidates.
- For Science Subjects i.e. Mathematical Sciences, Physical Sciences, Chemical Sciences & Life Sciences, the syllabus is same as of the CSIR-NET. However, the examination Pattern will be same as of the UGC-NET, described above. For all other subjects, the syllabus is same as of the UGC-NET.
- All old examination 's Questions Papers for Paper I, Paper II and Paper III for all the subjects
  are available in our website.
- The questions in all three papers will appear both in Gujarati and English versions (except for languages and science subjects). In case of any discrepancy in Gujarati and English version of questions in Paper-I, II and III, the English Version should be taken as final.
- Along with the Hall Ticket, The detailed instructions for the candidates will also be uploaded on GSET website www.gujaratset.ac.in. Candidates may please see the instructions regarding use of test booklets, filling up the OMR Answer Sheet and other important instructions to be followed on the day of examination. It may be noted that instructions to candidates will not be sent to the candidate either by post or by e-mail.
- It is compulsory for Candidate to appear in all three papers. A candidate who does not appear in paper-I, will not be permitted to appear in paper-II and paper-III.

- The candidate will have to mark the responses for questions of Paper-I, Paper-II and Paper-III on the OMR answer sheet provided separately.
- The candidate shall have to return the original OMR Sheet of Paper I & II together and Paper III
  to the Invigilator before leaving the examination hall / room. However, candidates are allowed to
  carry the Test Booklets of Paper I, II and III along with duplicate copy (carbonless copy) of OMR
  Sheet on conclusion of examination.
- The Answer key(s) for all question papers will be uploaded on the GSET website www.gujaratset.ac.in before preparation of the Final Result of GSET Examination. Candidate(s) appeared in GSET Examination can download the Answer key(s).
- In case, the candidates, who are not satisfied with the answer key(s), may challenge the answer key(s) by sending a written request to the Member Secretary, Gujarat State Eligibility Test, The Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda, B Block, Chameli Baug, Nr. University Guest House, Prof. C. C. Mehta Road, Vadodara 390 002 supporting his / her stand with standard books / literature along with the Demand Draft of Rs. 1,000/- per question in favour of the " Member Secretary, GSET" payable at Vadodara, within stipulated time period given for the same. The envelope should be marked "Grievance Regarding Answer Key(s) of GSET Examination". The request(s) so received will be placed before the Expert Committee(s). In case the challenge of any candidate regarding answer key(s) is accepted, the fee will be refunded to such candidate. In all other cases the fee once paid will not be refunded. GSET Agency's decision on the challenges shall be final and the result will be declared on the basis of final answer keys.
- The marks of all the candidates will be placed on GSET website: www.gujaratset.ac.in soon after
  the declaration of the result. Besides this, GSET Agency will not issue any mark sheet to any
  qualified / not-qualified candidate. . The GSET Agency will issue certificates to the qualifying
  candidates only.
- No Grievances with regards to answer key(s) after declaration of result of GSET will be entertained.
- No TRAVEL ALLOWANCE will be paid to the candidates on account of appearing in the examination etc.
- There are no negative marks for incorrect answers.
- There is no provision of re evaluations.
- Canvassing, before or after Examination, in any form will disgualify the candidate.
- The decision of GSET Agency shall be final in all matters.
- All legal disputes pertaining to this GSET Examination shall fall within the jurisdiction of Vadodara Courts only.
